



Mr Mc's Easter Egg QR code shape hunt



Hello!

Thank you for downloading my Easter egg shape hunt activity.

What do you need?

A smart phone, ipad or tablet will do the trick. You will need to download a 'QR code reader' from the app store.

You can get them for FREE (ohhh yes).

When you download the QR code scanner, use it to scan the QR code that is on the egg. This will take you to a Youtube page, which will then play you a set of clues from Mini Mc. These clues are describing either a 2D or 3D shape.

Lesson / activity ideas:

- Place them around the classroom/school and send the children on an Easter egg hunt using ipads/tablets. They can scan the code, listen to the description and...
 - talk to a partner and tell you what shape they think it is
 - draw the shape on a piece of paper or whiteboard
 - show you what shape it is using a feely bag of shapes
 - make the shape using lolly sticks at each egg station or sticks put into plastic wallets that they can carry around (for the 3D shapes they could actually build the shape using sticks and playdough/blutack to hold it together
 - For the 3D shapes have 2 different 3D shapes at the egg, can they select the correct 3D shape.
 - Have a range of shapes on offer at each egg...take a selfie with the correct shape!!!
